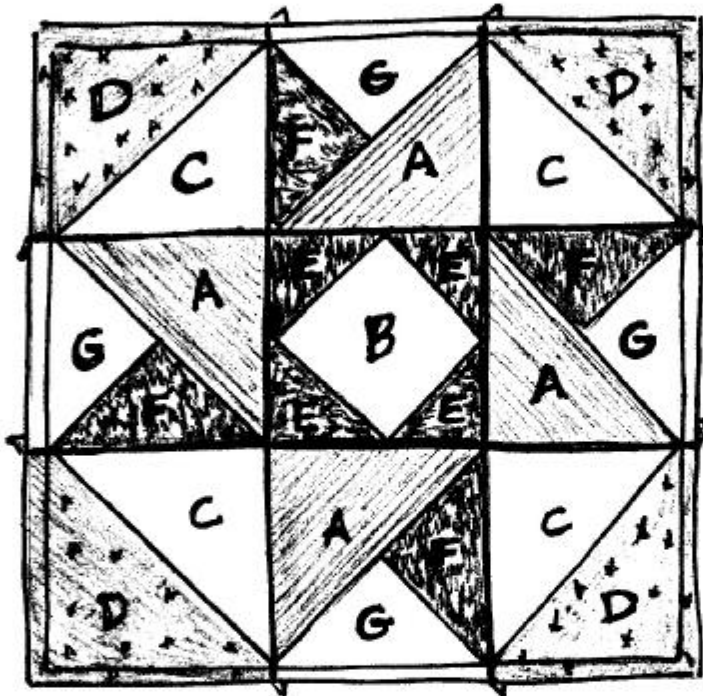


# SLO Quilters Block-A-Month

## Twisted Friends 12 1/2" unfinished

May 2011

- A- (2) 4 7/8" squares medium or dark fabrics
- B- (1) 4 1/2" square light background fabric
- C- (2) 4 7/8" squares same fabric as B
- D- (2) 4 7/8" squares, med. or dark fabric-save a 3" strip for sashing
- E- (4) 2 1/2" squares, med. or dark fabric-needs contrast to A
- F- (1) 5 1/2" square cut twice diagonally—same fabric as E
- G- (1) 5 1/2" square, cut twice diagonally—same fabric as C & B



### Sewing:

1. Make 4 D/C units by drawing a diagonal line on back of C's, corner to corner. Lay right sides together with D and sew 1/4" away on both sides of line. Cut on drawn line and press toward D.



2. Lay each E on each corner of B, one at a time. Sew on drawn diagonal line. Trim only E fabric as shown and press toward corners.



3. Make 4 G/F units. Press toward darker fabric. Sew each unit to A. Press toward A.

4. Assemble rows as shown. Press in opposite directions.

5. Pinning at intersections, sew rows together. Press towards middle row.
